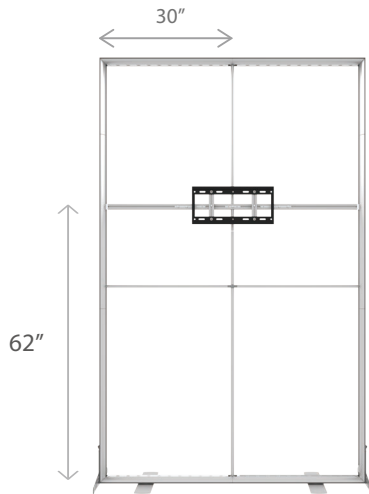


# Monitor Mount

Designed for compatibility with BrightLine and StraightLine Displays, these mounts deliver a captivating “floating” screen sensation. Simply slide the TV bar into the frame, secure the monitor plate with screws, and attach your screen on the front. Side feet are included in the kit for extra stability. Graphics can be finished with four small pre-cut slits for convenient access, or you can customize your own cutouts as required.

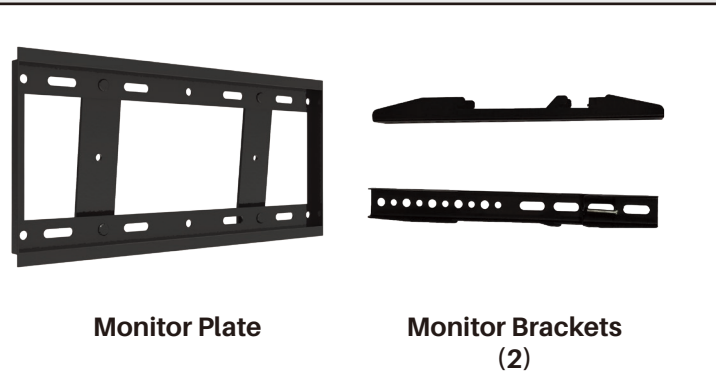

\*Remove M6 Screws from TV Bar, using Allen key.

\*Remove M6 Screws from TV Bar, using Allen key.

\*Use cutter to create a 1" vertical slit on fabric, where M6 screws fit on TV bar. Don't worry fabric will not run.

9

\*Attach monitor plate with M6 screws, using Allen key. Add spacers as needed.

10

\*Attach monitor plate with M6 screws, using Allen key. Add spacers as needed.

11

\*Attach monitor plate with M6 screws, using Allen key. Add spacers as needed.

12

\*Attach brackets to monitor and hang on the plate.

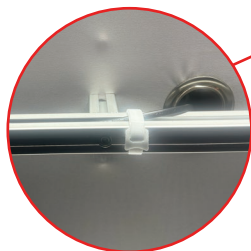

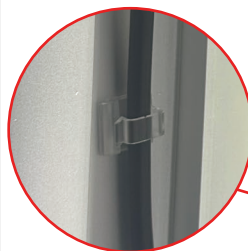
You will need 10ft Extension Cable

Connect the extension cable to your TV. Route cable inside the groove of the TV bar and use cable ties to secure in place.

2



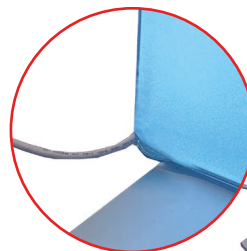
Attach wire clips to the frame. Then route the cable through and secure within the clips.

3



Route cable through the bottom corner of the frame.

4



Secure the vertical end of the graphic first, adjust cable, then finish with the bottom of the fabric
